Energy Efficient Lighting in India

This project was developed by the Bureau of Energy Efficiency (BEE) to promote energy efficient lighting in India, thus reducing the electricity, and therefore carbon emissions generated from the grid. When established, around 76% of India's electricity was generated from coal – and so by reducing energy consumption and efficiency, over 35,000 tonnes of CO₂e are offset each year.

Nkhata Bay Cook Stove Project – Malawi

The Nkhata Bay Cook Stove Project aims to improve the livelihoods, health, and environment of 200,000 people in Nkhata Bay District, Malawi by distributing high-efficiency biomass cook stoves to 22,000 households. The project aims to reduce deforestation, respiratory diseases, burns, and greenhouse gas emissions by saving wood consumption and reducing smoke and fire hazards.

Salkhit Wind Farm— Mongolia

The Salkhit Wind Farm is the first grid-connected wind farm in Mongolia. The project generates renewable electricity using wind power resources and supplies it to the Mongolian central electricity system grid to meet the growing electricity demand.

The polyester used in our collections is made from recycled plastic bottles. That means by wearing Clubclass Corporate Clothing you are preventing plastic bottles reaching our oceans and landfill.

Reduced plastic packaging

In 2021 we stopped using hangers for waistcoats, skirts and trousers. They are now carefully folded and packaged in recycled packaging.

Packing your order

All of the board used in the production of Clubclass cartons is made from at least 90% recycled fibres and 100% of the carton can be recycled again – they're also fully biodegradable. Any new material used comes from managed softwood forests that are certified as sustainable.

When we pack your order we select the most appropriate carton. We then pack efficiently, and partner with a leading parcel carrier who commit that every parcel they deliver is carbon neutral.
